Queen Victoria & Victorian Era

Queen Victoria was born on 24 May 1819 in Kensington Palace as a princess Alexandrina Victoria of Kent. Her coronation was on 28 June 1838



when she was only 18. In February 1840 she married her cousin Albert of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha and they had nine children together. At the end of her life she was very fat. Victoria died on 22 January 1901. She died forty years after her husband. She reigned for 64 years and that period is called the Victorian Era.

The Victorian Era was the golden age of English literature. Some of the most famous writers of that time were Charles Dickens, the three Bronte sisters, George Eliot and Thomas Hardy. They mostly wrote novels.

The British Empire was the largest empire in the world during the Victorian Era. One fourth of the world's population lived in the British Empire at that time.

Axolotl

Axolotl is an amphibian lizard. Axolotls are originally from Mexico.



Points of Interest

After hatching axolotls have gills, however, adult axolotls have functional lungs and they can breathe through their skin.

Axolotls grow up to 30 cm in length.

Axolotls are carnivores. When they are young, they eat larvae, ants and similar small creatures, as adults they also eat earthworms and small fish.

Researchers proved that adult axolotls can regenerate even parts of their brains.

Although axolotls may live for up to 15 years in captive, in the wild axolotls live only for about five or six years.

Housing Axolotls

If you wanted to have an axolotl at home, you would need at least a 56-75 litre tank. Also, you would have to make sure that the tank has a secured top as it's not uncommon for these animals to try to jump out.

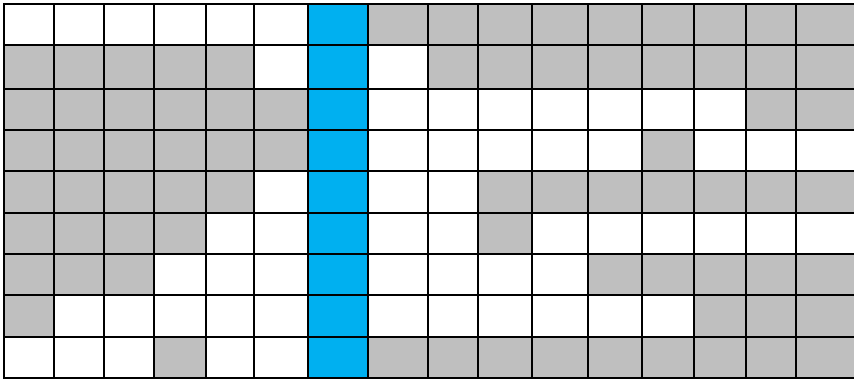
